As Toronto's Jewish community grows and evolves, strong leadership is needed to face the exciting challenges that lie ahead, and ensure continued growth. The Joshua Institute for Jewish Communal Leadership, Future Volunteers program, was created to ensure that new leadership is cultivated and ready to take on these compelling challenges. In partnership with the Rotman School of Management, the program will feature a unique mix of group sessions, and individual tutoring and mentoring. Further enhancing the program will be Career Pathing, provided to each graduate of the program, with the goal of ensuring a cadre of highly qualified, involved, active leaders in the Jewish community. This intense investment will be made in a small group of future leaders who will have the ability to influence many, and ensure that Toronto's Jewish community thrives.

The Future Volunteers program will be launched in September 2009. Focusing on volunteers, aged 30 to 50, we are looking for people who have demonstrated great leadership potential and a desire to become active, involved members in Toronto's innovative and prestigious Jewish community.

We are asking for your help in identifying these future leaders, by nominating individuals who exhibit inspiring leadership. You may nominate more than one person. Nominees should be:

- between the ages of 30 and 50
- demonstrating strong leadership either within or outside, the Jewish community
- representative of the diversity in the Jewish community

All completed nominations will be reviewed by the volunteer and professional leadership of the Joshua Institute. Selected candidates will be contacted and interviewed. Please note that not all the nominees will be invited for an interview. As such, confidentiality is of the utmost importance. Once the nomination forms have been reviewed, those candidates selected for an interview will be contacted. Upon completion of the interviews, all the candidates who were invited for an interview will be contacted and informed as to whether they will be accepted into the program. Please note that this is a small program, and not all candidates invited to an interview will have the opportunity to participate in the program.
